CLUB RULES FOR MEMBERS AND VISITORS

1. Standard of Behavior

1.1. The following types of behavior are unacceptable:

- Intoxication to a level that offends others,
- Swearing or other unacceptable language,
- Overly noisy behavior,
- Misuse of club property / assets / facilities
- Rudeness, verbal abuse, or physical violence directed to patrons or club staff,
- Non – compliance with club rules.

1.2. The duty Manger has the authority to remove those who do not comply with those standards, from the club premises.

1.3. If the duty manager takes action under 1.2, the details of the incident shall be reported to the Club Manager who will consider whether further action is required, including referral to the Management Committee.

2. Food and Alcohol

2.1. No food or alcohol is to be brought into the Club premises without the approval of the Club Manager.

3. Signing In

3.1. All members and visitors must sign in prior to entering the Club premises.

4. Children

4.1. Children must be supervised at all times by a responsible adult, and in particular when using the playground, swimming pool or Bistro areas.

4.2. Children are not permitted in the Bar area or the Gaming Room.

5. Dress Standards

5.1. The Club has a relaxed attitude towards dress except that:

- Dress should not offend other patrons,
- Body covering and footwear are required on Club premises except in the pool area.

6. Dogs

6.1. Dogs are not permitted in the Bar (except the Fisherman's Bar), Bistro, pool, or playground.

6.2. Dogs are permitted on the premises, except as detailed in 6.1, up to 6pm, as long as they are under the control of a responsible adult, and do not behave in a manner that offends patrons.

6.3. Those bringing dogs to the club are responsible for cleaning up after them.

7. Boat Registration

7.1. Active members with boats must submit their details to the club as determined by the Management Committee.

7.2. Crafts not eligible for registration with the Club include canoes, tenders and dinghies, or other craft as determined by the Management Committee, and which do not meet the requirement of the Club, or the intent of the Constitution.

7.3. Only one Active member may be allocated to a single registered boat.

8. Boat Parking

8.1. Active members wishing to use the Club's boat parking area must, in addition to paying the annual fee, agree to the terms and conditions in the Boat Parking Agreement, and abide by any directions from the Club in relation to use of the boat parking area.
